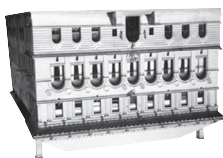

**Public Library** is a community-based membership organization dedicated to supporting and promoting The Newark Public Library through programs, advocacy and financial support.

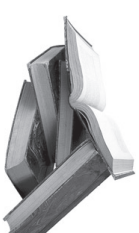

1. Read
2. Read

5. Read about everything

11. Don't think about reading, but
12. Just read
