Grey explains, "Our customers turn to us for technology assistance whether it is for access to computers and Wi-Fi, introductory training in computer basics, or more advanced classes for job readiness; the Newark Public Library stands ready to help. Funding from TD Charitable Foundation enables us to offer this schedule of computer classes, in both English and Spanish."

Classes taught in English for this September will be: Mouse on Saturday, September 7 from 11:30 am-12:30 pm and Tuesday, September 17 from 2:00-3:00 pm; Email 1 on Tuesday, September 4 from 6:00-8:00 pm and Saturday, September 14 from 12:30-2:30 pm; Email 2 on Saturday, September 28 from 12:30-2:30 pm; Internet on Tuesday, September 10 from 6:00-8:00 pm and Thursday, September 26 from 2:00-4:00 pm; Word 1 on Wednesday, September 11 from 6:00-8:00 pm and Thursday, September 19 from 6:00-8:00 pm; Word 2 on Wednesday, September 25 from 6:00-8:00 pm; Excel 1 on Tuesday, September 3 from 6:00-8:00 pm and Excel 2 on Tuesday, September 17 from 6:00-8:00 and Saturday, September 21 from 10:00 am-12:00 pm. The Introductory Resume Preparation class will be held on Thursday, September 5 from 6:00-8:00 pm, Saturday, September 21 from 12:30-2:30 pm and on Tuesday, September 24 from 6:00-8:00 pm. The Advanced Resume Clinic will be offered on Monday, September 16 from 2:00-4:00 pm.
