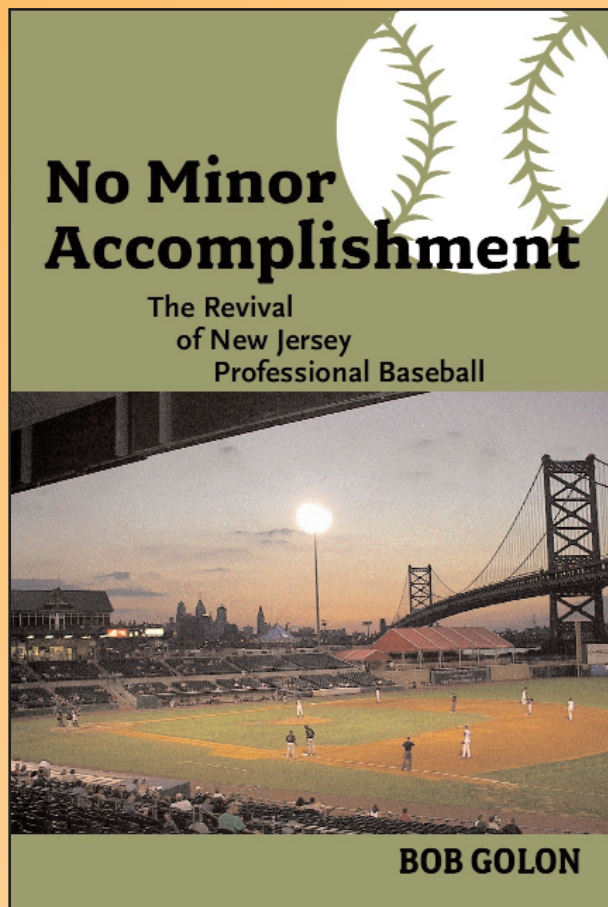

Despite a couple of attempts to revive baseball, it was essentially non-existent in New Jersey from 1951 through 1993. Finally, in 1994, with the help of both private investors and local politicians, minor league baseball resurfaced in new ballparks in Trenton and Augusta. These clubs were soon followed by Atlantic City, Bridgewater, Newark and Camden. Baseball is once again booming in New Jersey and *No Minor Accomplishment: The Revival of New Jersey Professional Baseball* tells its story, from not only a baseball perspective, but from community, state and fans perspectives.
