Nala Toussaint

Brooklyn born with an Afro-Caribbean background, Nala Toussaint works to advance the social and economic wellbeing of African Descendants, with an urgent focus on queer, same-gender loving people, transgender, and nonbinary people, and ultimately the entire community. She has done extensive work as an outreach liaison, conducting safe sex intervention activities for youths, and coordinating educational and job development services at renowned LGBT public service organizations.
