***Victoria Foundation Funds Jobs Skills Classes at the Newark
Public Library***

The Victoria Foundation has generously given \$30,000 to the Newark Public Library for job skills classes and supporting materials. The classes for October cover the Internet, basic and advanced Email, Microsoft Word and Excel, and Introduction to Resume Preparation. Librarians will also use the grant to purchase new resume writing and interviewing guides as well as books about computer applications taught in the classes.
