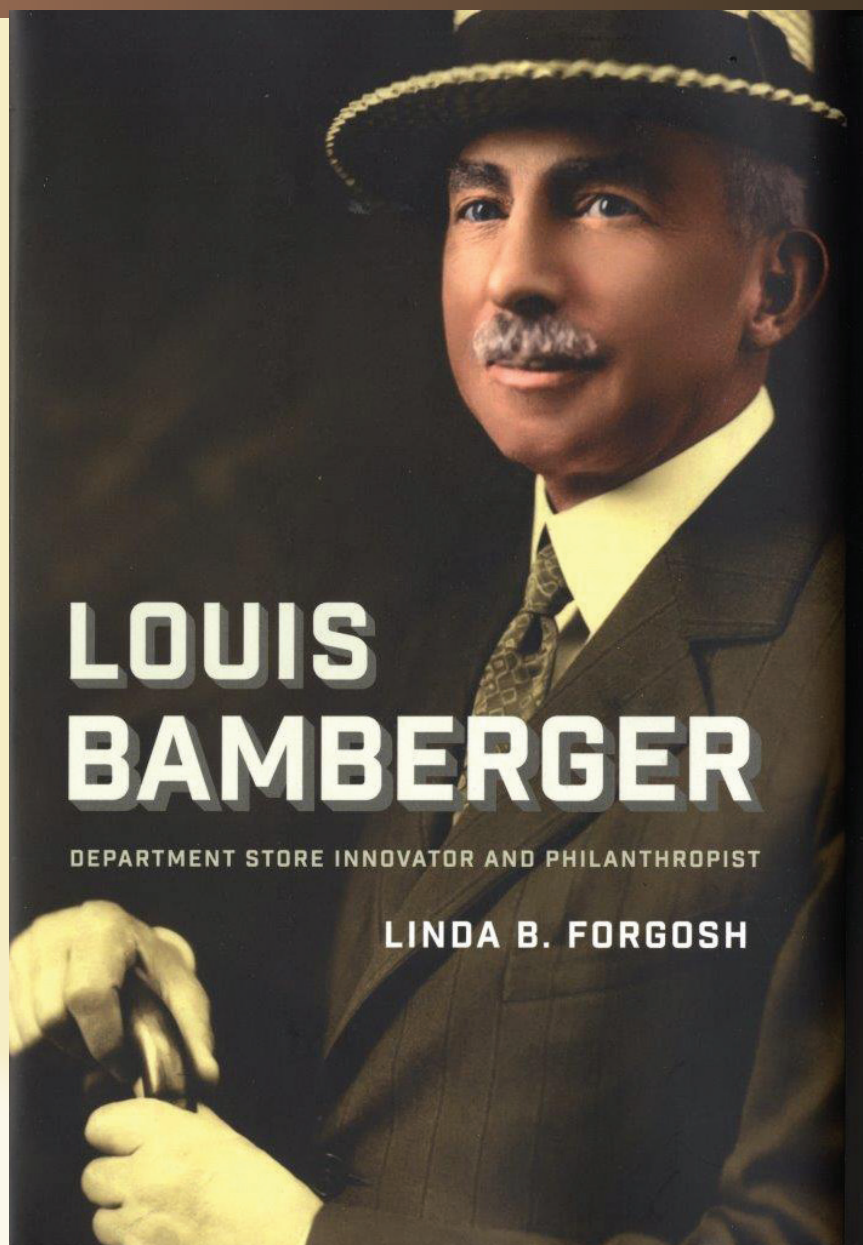

Louis Bamberger (1855–1944) was a department store magnate, merchandising genius, and enlightened philanthropist. This son of German immigrants built his business—the great, glamorous L. Bamberger & Co.—into the fourth-largest department store in the country. His story will interest historians, readers of Jewish history, New Jerseyans fascinated by local history, and the Newarkers for whom Bamberger's was a beloved local institution.
