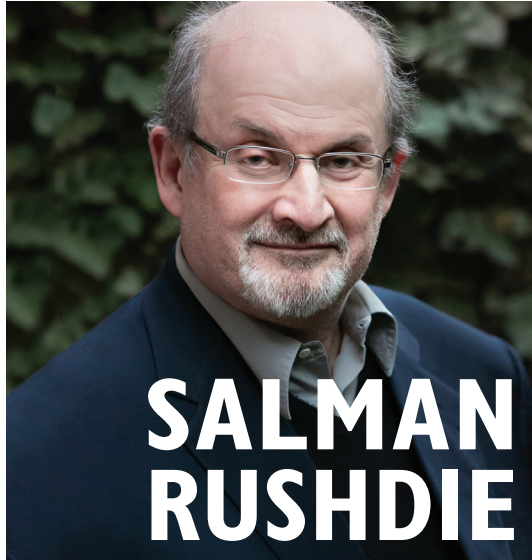
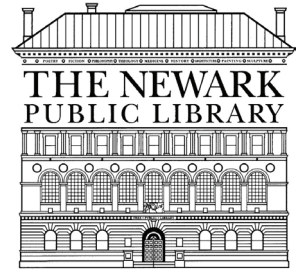

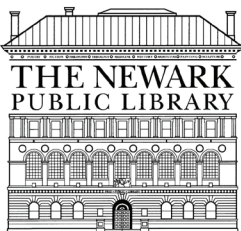

He is also the author of a book of stories, *East, West*, and four works of non-fiction, including his memoir *Joseph Anton*.
